- 5. Stay informed about committee matters, is prepared for meetings, and reviews and comments on minutes and reports.
- 6. Build a collegial working relationship with other committee members that contributes to consensus.
- 7. Participates in the committee's annual meeting and planning efforts.
- 8. Be a member of the Woodridge Community Association in good standing (dues current).
